Haas brings clear concepts and transformations of matter where something is unstable and "liquid" (optical glass, waves, frequencies, sound resonances, laser beams up to explosions and pulsation of space), what is later transformed into a solid state of convincing stories full of optical acrylics, rhythmic reliefs from plexiglas or diamond grindings.

Today, Asot Haas is a proven brand in the world of gallerists and collectors, with a hallmark of exclusivity on an art market in the field of architecture, design and optical art. His art is all about an intelligent visual cipher using new technologies, geometric algorithms and dynamic variability...
